

Report from Camp Fallujah, Iraq: A770 survives terrorist attack ...

Names of individuals or units have been withheld due to the classified nature of the activity.

“On Friday, 10 Mar 06, [our vehicle] sustained damage from a [car bomb] at the location it was deployed to on 6 Mar 06. Damage to the unit includes broken windshield, vent window blown out, acquisition chassis torn from mount, CB box torn from wall and hoop shroud broken. Preliminary checks reveal that the [generator set] will not start. Until it is brought in there is no way to tell at this point what if any other damage it may have sustained, the unit was running at the time of the explosion.”

***The [GETAC A770] remote laptop which was in the tower when it was destroyed survived and is operable.** The power supply for remote laptop is missing, and the keys for the vehicle were also in the tower and are missing. Condition of the Mercedes chassis is not known at this time.*

Attached are some [photos] of some of the damage. In looking at the photos keep in mind that the blast occurred approximately 125 yards away.”
